Dear Tenants:

Please be aware the Rockhill Property Management Office was notified yesterday evening that an individual who is employed by one of our vendors in 100 High Street has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. We understand that this individual was last in the building on August 3, 2021. We further understand that the individual is self-isolating and has not been on-site since that time. In addition, it is our understanding that the affected individual was wearing a face covering a majority of the time when last in the common areas of the building.

As we have indicated in prior communications, the building's high traffic common areas have been cleaned regularly using products with EPA-approved viral pathogen claims, and with an emphasis on high touch points including door handles, elevator call buttons and restroom fixtures. In addition, a deep cleaning of the common areas that the individual is reported to have traveled within the building was completed last night utilizing products with EPA-approved emerging viral pathogen claims.

Please know that we will continue to track the timing and suspected path of travel of any new cases and will conduct our enhanced cleaning protocol as previously described.
