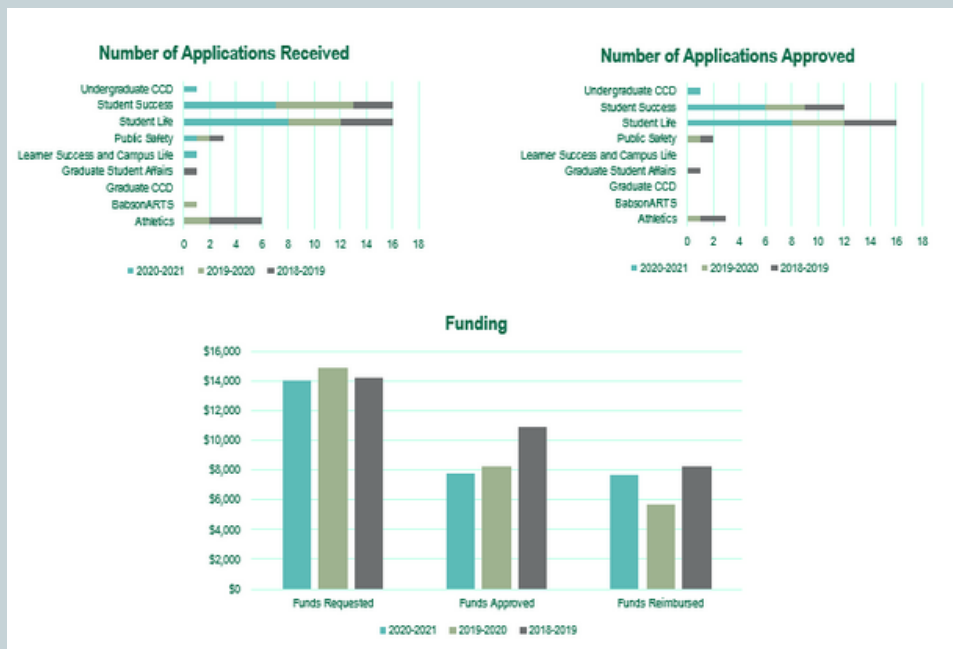
## Division Restructure

## Undergraduate Professional Accelerator Fund

The Undergraduate Professional Accelerator Fund provides funding for undergraduate students to pursue professional and personal development opportunities outside of Babson College.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Undergraduate Professional Accelerator Fund only accepted applications for virtual experiences and as a result limited funding was awarded, as most virtual experiences were free of charge to students. The experience that was funded was for the Class Action 8th Annual First Generation College Student Summit that was virtually attended by 12 students and 2 staff.



## Financial Support for Divisional Initiatives

Unused funds from UPAF were allocated to support various initiatives within the Division in order to enhance the student experience.
